What comes to mind when you think about summer?
Swimming? Summer camp? Barbecues? Music in the park?
This year, why not “Dig Into Reading” and make the library part of your summer fun?

Summer reading at the library starts on June 5, (the last day of school) and runs until August 24. All you need to do is sign up at the library and pick up your reading log. Independent (chapter book) readers record the number of pages they read and pre-readers, or beginner readers, record the minutes read (either by themselves or with someone).

Everyone who completes their reading log and turns it in before August 24 will receive a free book, prizes, and be entered into a drawing for the **GRAND PRIZE**.

We will start our summer fun by “Digging Into Dirt” and planting flower seeds on Thursday, June 6, at 1:00 p.m.

- Thursday Activities at 1:00 p.m. – every Thursday, beginning June 6 through August 22, we will have an activity or craft.
- Storytime for Everyone is every Friday, beginning June 7, 11:00 am.

All of the library’s books are labeled with Accelerated Reading (AR) levels and points so you can read in your level all summer.

The library has the latest movies on DVD.

The library has new computers - all with Microsoft Office (provided by The Pokagon Fund).

If you want a book the library doesn’t have, it can be ordered from another library and delivered, usually within one week.

With your library card you can learn a new language with Rocket Languages and download – for **FREE** – three MP3 songs per week.
