We will be participating with many other Berrien County libraries to put on a Writer's Conference at Niles District Library on April 13, 2024.

The FCC's E-Rate program makes telecommunications and information services more affordable for schools and libraries. With funding from the Universal Service Fund (fcc.gov/general/universal-service-fund), E-Rate provides discounts for telecommunications, Internet access, and internal connections to eligible schools and libraries. Our discount is based on the percentage of free and reduced lunches at our local school so we receive an 80% discount. We pay \$118 per month and erate pays \$472 per month. That is how we have such fantastic and fast internet. We pay a fee of 10% of the erate funding amount we receive to hire an erate consulting firm to process our paperwork because applying for erate is hard to navigate and very time-consuming if you're doing it on your own. We use the same company that most of the local schools do.

Last month there were questions about collection development and deselection so I've included a copy of the board's Collection Development Policy that was adopted May 9, 2023.

I was able to purchase two book carts and a projector cart from the online auction for River Valley last month. One of the carts is almost like new.
