May 2025 circulation statistics:

- 1,286 total circulation: 773 physical items checked out + 475 e-items checked out (Libby, hoopla, Kanopy) + 38 magazines (on Libby).
- 47 items borrowed via inter-library loan, 49 items lent via inter-library loan
- 5 people checked out 38 magazines on Libby
- 32 people used public computers
- 28 in-person programs were offered last month & 45 people attended. 30 people participated in passive programming.
