June 2025 circulation statistics:

- 1,658 total circulation: 1,108 physical items checked out + 483 e-items checked out (Libby, hoopla, Kanopy) + 67 magazines (on Libby).
- 22 items borrowed via inter-library loan, 21 items lent via inter-library loan
- 16 people checked out 67 magazines on Libby
- 55 people used public computers
- 27 in-person programs were offered last month & attendance was 108. 35 people participated in passive programming.
