Community Notes



Have you signed up for alerts from the Berrien County Sheriff's Office Emergency Management's Notification Service?

B-WARN! Is a service you may sign up for to receive emergency alerts via calls on your landline, calls or texts on your cell phone, or messages via pager, fax and/or email.

If you choose to opt-in, you will be notified about Berrien County Alerts such as 911 outages, missing & endangered persons, states of emergency, etc.

B-WARN will also notify you of weather alerts, such as severe storms, floods, fires, snow, and marine updates for the lake.

How It Works:

When a notification is issued about a public safety concern, an official message will be sent via the voice or text communication methods that you have entered during registration.

When the system determines it has contacted you and delivered the message, you will not be contacted by any subsequent methods regarding that particular notification. If the system determines it has not delivered the message, it will continue to attempt to reach you at all of the contact methods that you have registered. The messages are delivered based upon locations that emergency officials request the message to be sent to. If it is a County-Wide emergency, the message will be sent County-Wide. If it is a localized emergency, the area in which the message is delivered will be smaller.

The really fantastic part about all of this is that the system can call your landline with notifications – there is no need to use a cell phone or email!

And you may opt-out anytime you like.
