A Word from the Director:

What a year 2020 was! In addition to the pandemic and being closed for two months, at the library we welcomed five brand-new board members and bid farewell to a long-time employee.

Six board members were sworn in on December 8, 2020. They are: Debi Kearney, Tom Pauly, Patience Petro, Tom Rosenbluth, Connie Slavens, and Chris Zebell.

We celebrated Karen Lubarski's retirement from the library on November 25, 2020. Karen will be greatly missed. We welcomed Erin Przybylinski to the role of curator of our Jane Ward Genealogy Room. Erin's office hours are Wednesday, 10-5, or by appointment.

In 2020 our patrons saved \$107,211 by using the library! They borrowed: over 8,000 physical items (books, audiobooks, and DVDs), almost 300 physical items from inter-library loan, over 180 items from our Library of Things (hot spots, puzzles, games, etc.) over 730 digital downloads on hoopla, over 2,000 digital downloads on Libby/Overdrive, and over 20 digital downloads on Kanopy (this platform was introduced to our patrons at the end of November). We lent over 200 physical items out to other Michigan libraries via inter-library loan.

If you aren't familiar with our online resources, make sure you check out Kanopy, hoopla digital, and Libby/Overdrive. These can be accessed anywhere and anytime via the internet. If you need assistance, don't be afraid to call us at 756-5621. We're happy to talk you through it.

Begining January 9, 2021 we will resume Saturday hours, 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Our building remains open and we have no plans to close it unless it is mandated by the state or health department. When you do come to the library, you are required to wear a mask and maintain social distance from others that do not live in your household, and lingering is discouraged. If you choose not to come in the building, we are still offering curbside pickup. To place requests you may call us at 756-5621 and we will let you know when your order will be ready; or you may log in online at https://threeoaks.biblionix.com/catalog/ and reserve items yourself, we will then call you when your items are ready. Please do not come to the library if you feel sick or have recently been sick.

Happy New Year from the staff at Three Oaks Library. We hope to see YOU soon!


