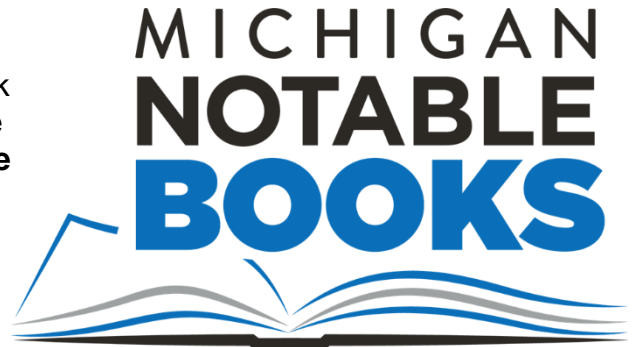

Get Ready for the Peeps Diorama Contest! 🐣

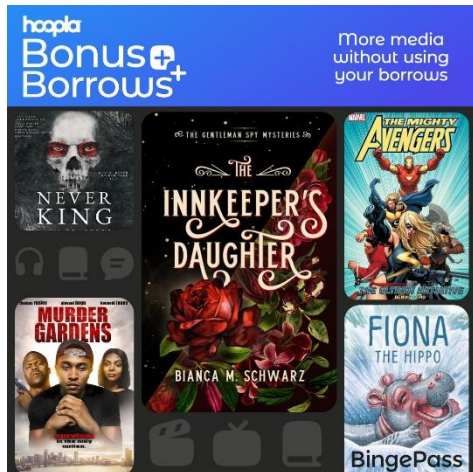
It's almost time for the second annual **Three Oaks Townsh Public Library Peeps Diorama Contest!**

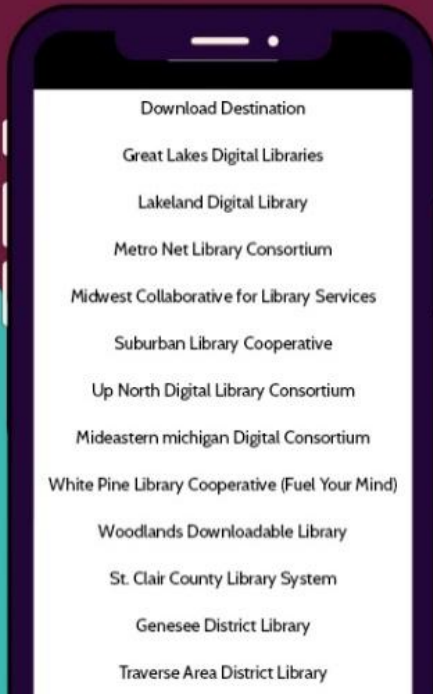

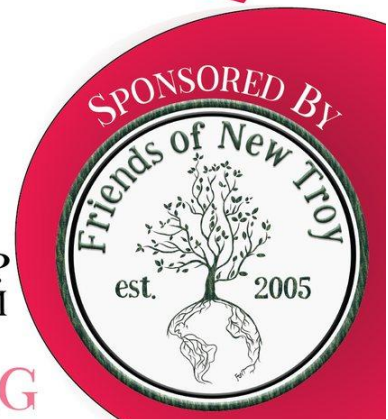
