Stay tuned for details regarding Summer Reading and the River Valley Elementary Art Show at the library.

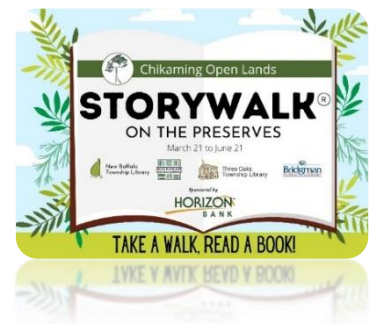
This month our Take and Make bags for children feature a cute bumble bee bag with a butterfly craft. All Take and Make bags are available on a first come, first served, basis.
