We are excited to now offer Hoopla to our patrons! Hoopla is a digital media lending service that allows library patrons to instantly borrow eBooks, audiobooks, comics, movies, TV shows, and music. Audiobooks, ebooks and comics can be borrowed for three weeks; movie and TV shows can be borrowed for three days; and music albums can be borrowed for one week. All content is available with no holds or waiting and will automatically be returned after the lending period is up.
